- The deadline for submitting all paperwork, trophies, plaques, and photographs to Marilyn Hartman is **Saturday, January 7, 2012.**
- These materials may be mailed or delivered in person to her at W5134 Rienzi Road, Fond du Lac, WI 54935.
- You may also wish to hand deliver them to her at the annual Potluck Meeting in December.
- All materials for each dog (paperwork, plaques, photos, etc.) must be submitted together—no piecemeal submissions!!!
- Make sure to label your photographs.

If your dog is to be awarded a plaque for the first time, make sure to include a photograph—this makes the presentation of the awards so much more meaningful to you and to everyone in attendance. You are also encouraged to update your current photograph if you wish—simply submit the new photo along with the plaque. NFGRC will recognize AKC, CKC, UKC, GRCA, NADAC, and NAHRA titles.

We would also like to honor the dogs who played a special part in our lives but who died this past year. Please bring a photo and include a few words of past accomplishments, etc. if you wish. This write-up will be included in our awards booklet and should be submitted by January 7th just like an award application.

## ATTENTION

This year, NFGRC is implementing an on-line fill-in-the-blank form. We are hoping to make the process easier for owners, the trophy coordinator, and the program author and designer. Therefore, you will find that you should complete two separate forms for the Awards Banquet.

The first form is your application for any award or plaque. This form will be submitted in hard copy to Marilyn Hartman **AT THE SAME TIME** you give her a previous plaque, photo, or other materials. A few blank copies of this form will be available at the banquet to hand print as in the past. The preferred method, however, is for you to fill out and then print out the form.

The second form is your award/s Title Story. Ideally, this will be sent directly to Cindy Pischke. You may, of course, print it and submit it with your other paperwork to Marilyn, or you can save it and attach it to an e-mail directly to Cindy. You should have this form submitted to Cindy via e-mail at the same time you submit the other paperwork. No late paperwork will be accepted.

## Northern Flyway Golden Retriever Club Top Conformation Award

This trophy, donated by Mary A. Strange and Mrs. Mary Strange, shall be awarded to the adult Golden Retriever which, in one year, accumulates the most wins in breed ring competition as per the point system outlined below. This trophy will be awarded to the owner of the top winning Golden Retriever adult at the Annual NFGRC Awards Banquet. The owner's name and the dog's registered name will be inscribed on the trophy. A commemorative plate for the award plaque will also be awarded. The winning Golden Retriever must have been awarded at least one point in AKC breed competition.

## Northern Flyway Golden Retriever Club Top Puppy Conformation Award

This trophy, donated by Deborah Elliott Krebsbach, shall be awarded to the puppy Golden Retriever which, in one year, accumulates the most wins in breed ring competition as per the point system outlined below. The trophy, a cold-cast bronze Bydand sculpture mounted on a wooden base, will be awarded to the owner of the top winning Golden Retriever puppy at the Annual NFGRC Awards Banquet. A commemorative plate for the award plaque will also be awarded.

***Please note:** A dog is eligible for only **one** top conformation award—indicate **Puppy or Top Conformation** on your application. The point system for the top conformation awards is as follows:*

Best of Breed	15 points	<i>Class wins (Puppy through Open):</i>	
Best of Opposite Sex	12 points	First place	4 points
Best of Winners	10 points	Second place	3 points
Winners Dog/Bitch	6 points	Third place	2 points
Reserve Dog/Bitch	5 points	Fourth place	1 point

***Please note:** Only **one point allotment** is earned per win. All wins must be earned at AKC licensed shows. A dog awarded BOB from the classes over Special(s) adds 5 points; any Group placement is 25 points, and Best in Show earns 50 points. A puppy awarded Best of Breed Puppy shall be awarded 5 points. Any puppy Group placement earns 8 points; Best Puppy in Show earns 10 points.*

## Northern Flyway Golden Retriever Club MACH Agility Trophy

This award, donated by Cindy Pischke and Golden Touch of Paws artist Ida Marino, shall be awarded on an annual basis to the NFGRC member-owned Golden Retriever (s) earning an AKC Master Agility Championship title (MACH). This trophy, a cold-cast bronze sculpture of a Golden Retriever on an A-frame, shall be presented at the Annual NFGRC Awards Banquet. A commemorative plate will also be awarded. If more than one handler qualifies for this trophy, it will be awarded to all who qualify. Each handler and dog name will appear on the trophy; each will receive a commemorative plate for their respective award plaque and each handler will be allowed to keep the trophy for a portion of the year in which it is awarded.

# **Northern Flyway Golden Retriever Club Obedience Competition Awards**

## **Beginner Novice High Point Award**

This trophy, donated by Gabe Marquart, Starshine Golden Retrievers, shall be awarded to the member-owned Golden Retriever who attains the three highest combined scores from the Beginner Novice class in AKC licensed obedience competition. A first and second place shall be awarded with commemorative plates for the award plaques.

## **Novice High Point Award**

This trophy, donated by Amy and Rick Krumenauer, Decorah Golden Retrievers, shall be awarded to the member-owned Golden Retriever who attains the three highest combined scores from the Novice classes in AKC licensed obedience competition. A first and second place shall be awarded with commemorative plates for the award plaques.

## **Graduate Novice High Point Award**

This trophy, donated by Judy Rathbun, Northwind Golden Retrievers, shall be awarded to the member-owned Golden Retriever who attains the three highest combined scores from the Graduate Novice class in AKC licensed obedience competition. A first and second place shall be awarded with commemorative plates for the award plaques.

## **Open High Point Award**

This trophy, donated by Dick and Peggy Battig, The Village Dog House, shall be awarded to the member-owned Golden Retriever who attains the three highest combined scores from the Open classes in AKC licensed obedience competition. A first and second place shall be awarded with commemorative plates for the award plaques.

## **Graduate Open High Point Award**

This trophy, donated by Cindy Pischke, Cima Golden Retrievers, shall be awarded to the member-owned Golden Retriever who attains the three highest combined scores from the Graduate Open class in AKC licensed obedience competition. A first and second place shall be awarded with commemorative plates for the award plaques.

## **Utility High Point Award**

This trophy, donated by Pat Vanden Heuvel, Woodwing Golden Retrievers, shall be awarded to the member-owned Golden Retriever who attains the three highest combined scores from the Utility classes in AKC licensed obedience competition. A first and second place shall be awarded with commemorative plates for the award plaques.

*Note: Only scores earned at AKC licensed obedience trials may be submitted for these awards.*

# Northern Flyway Golden Retriever Club Other Competition Awards

## Ariell Tracking Trophy

This trophy, donated by Jim and Ellen Hardin of Ariell Golden Retrievers, shall be awarded on an annual basis to the handler of the Golden Retriever who accomplishes the following:

1. Earns the AKC Tracking Dog, Tracking Dog Excellent or Variable Surface Tracking title on the first attempt (at the first test in which they participate); and
2. Is the first AKC Tracking Dog, TDX or VST title earned by the handler on any dog the handler has trained, owns or co-owns; and
3. The handler is a member of the NFGRC in good standing for the entire calendar year in which the Tracking Dog title is awarded by AKC.

For this trophy to be awarded, all three of the above conditions must be met. If more than one handler qualifies for this trophy, it will be awarded to all who qualify. Each handler and dog name will appear on the trophy; each will receive a commemorative plate for their respective award plaque and each handler will be allowed to keep the trophy for a portion of the year in which it is awarded.

## Magic's Poor Little Rich Girl Versatility Award

This trophy, donated in honor of UUD, Can OTCH Magic's Poor Little Rich Girl, JH, WCX, Am/Can UDT, Can WCI, NAHRA SR, is to be awarded to the NFGRC member-owned Golden Retriever receiving the most points in a minimum of three categories, in any country's registry open to the Golden Retriever. Points must be accumulated in one year (January 1 to December 31) as follows:

## High Point Field Trophy

This award, donated by David Teasdale, shall be awarded annually to the top winning Golden Retriever owned by a NFGRC member, which, in one year, accumulates the most wins in AKC Field Trial competition as per the point system outlined below. This trophy, a hand-carved duck decoy mounted on a walnut base, shall be presented to the owner of the top winning Field Trial Golden Retriever at the Annual NFGRC Awards Banquet. A commemorative plate for the award plaque will also be awarded.

*The point system for the High Point Field Trial Trophy is as follows:*

First place	5 points
Second place	3 points
Third place	2 points
Fourth place	1 point

Scale will apply first to any Golden Retriever earning the most All-Age points at AKC Licensed Field Trials. If none, scale will apply to most points earned in Derby/Qualifying stakes at AKC Licensed Field Trials. If none, scale will apply to most points earned in AKC Sanctioned Field Trial events, including all stakes except Puppy. If no NFGRC member-owned Golden Retriever earns points in any given year, the trophy shall be retained by the previous year's winner until the following year.

## Junior Hunter Retriever Trophy

This award, donated by Deborah Seline of Pemberley Retrievers, shall be awarded annually to the member owner-handled Golden Retriever which earns a JH title in the first four hunting tests in which said dog competes. If more than one handler qualifies for this trophy, it will be awarded to all who qualify. Each handler and dog name will appear on the trophy; each will receive a commemorative plate for their respective award plaque and each handler will be allowed to keep the trophy for a portion of the year in which it is awarded.
